

Trimble Data Manager

Trimble® Data Manager is a file explorer application for Android™, designed to simplify how you manage and transfer project files. Trimble Data Manager addresses the challenges of moving data on Android devices by providing a simple, intuitive interface similar to Windows File Explorer. It enables you to:

- Transfer files reliably — safely copy project and job files to USB-C drives, preventing the file corruption that can occur when a device is disconnected too early.
- Navigate with ease — access your Trimble application project folders and device storage as simple, easy-to-navigate drives.
- Simplify your workflow — move files seamlessly between your device and USB storage.

Download and install Trimble Data Manager

Download Trimble Data Manager from the Google Play™ Store.



Granting access permissions

The first time you launch Trimble Data Manager, you are prompted to allow the app access to a few functions on your device; you must grant permissions for the app to work correctly.

1. In the **Storage Permissions** dialog, tap **Allow**.
2. In the **All files access** screen, enable **Allow access to manage all files**. Allowing Trimble Data Manager access to manage your files enables you to perform file functions without the app (moving, renaming, and deleting files).
3. In the **Install unknown apps** screen, enable **Allow from this source**. Allowing Trimble Data Manager to install unknown apps allows you to start applications with Trimble Data Manager.

Before you can transfer files between your device and a USB drive, you must also grant permissions to open and share files on each USB drive that you use.

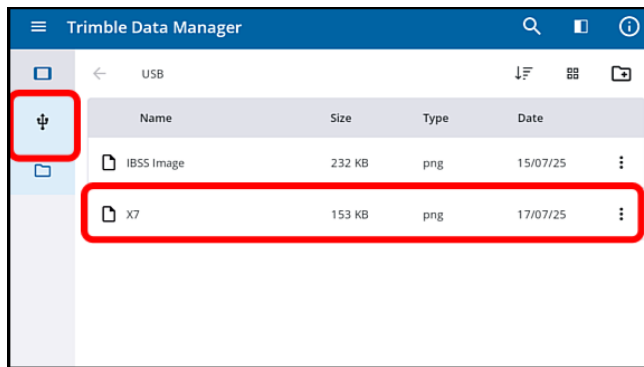
Accessing and navigating files on a USB drive

When a USB drive is connected, tap the **USB** tab in the Sidebar to access its contents.

USB settings and permissions

The first time you attempt to open or share a file from a newly connected USB drive, you are guided through the following permission steps, which will allow Trimble Data Manager to remember your USB drive:

1. When you are ready to transfer files with a thumb drive, connect the USB drive to the device. The external drive icon will darken when it's ready for use.



2. Tap any file in the external drive to continue to the next step.
3. Tap **USE THIS FOLDER**.
4. In the **Allow TDM to access files in <<USB drive>>?** dialog, tap **ALLOW**.
